EVACUATION ORDER

July 22, 2023 at 1800 hrs

Pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the *Emergency Program Act*, an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Thompson-Nicola Regional District Emergency Operations Centre (EOC), effective **July 22, 2023 at 1800 hrs**, because of the potential danger to life and safety due to wildfire.

An evacuation order is now in effect for approximately 49 addressed properties in the following areas of **Electoral Area "J" (Copper Desert Country)** and **Electoral Area "L" (Grasslands)**:

- 6388 to 6416 Ashley Rd;
- 1848 to 3345 Edith Lake Rd;
- 4180 to 4828 Goose Lake Rd;
- 4188 to 6455 Long Lake Rd;
- 700 to 860 McLeod Lake Rd;
- 5960 to 6381 Weir Rd; and
- as outlined on the attached map.

What You Should Do:

- If you are in the described area, you must leave immediately.
- To receive Emergency Support Services, please self-register using the Evacuee Registration & Assistance (ERA) tool: <https://ess.gov.bc.ca/>, **and** report to the Reception Centre, located at 1655 Island Pkwy, Kamloops, BC V2B 6Y9.
- Make arrangements to stay with family or friends (if possible).
- Gather family; take a neighbour or someone who needs help.
- Take pets in kennels or on a leash.

- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, keys) only if they are immediately available.

Emergency Support Services will only be provided if your primary residence is under evacuation order.
