EVACUATION ALERT

Ainslie Creek Wildfire

July 8, 2026, 1900 hrs

An **Evacuation Alert** has been issued by the Thompson-Nicola Regional District, effective July 8, 2026 at 1900 hours, due to the Ainslie Creek Wildfire.

The Evacuation Alert is now in effect for approximately 61 addressed properties in Electoral Areas "I" (**Blue Sky Country**) and "N" (**Beautiful Nicola Valley -South**).

Impacted areas are as follows:

- **All addressed properties West of Spius Creek including Petit Creek Road and Prospect Creek FSR, and any other properties as outlined on the attached map.**

This Evacuation Alert is in place to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to an Evacuation Order; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

What You Should Do:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be issued while separated.
- Pack essential items for quick departure, such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), and immediate care needs for dependents or pets. Pack keepsakes if time permits.
- Prepare a grab-and-go bag with clothing, toiletries, food, water, and medications.
- Arrange to stay with family or friends (if possible).
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/ or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and prepare to move animals and livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- If you are a livestock producer, ensure that you have your Premise ID in the event that you require support should an Evacuation Order be issued.

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- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles to be used in case of an Evacuation Order.

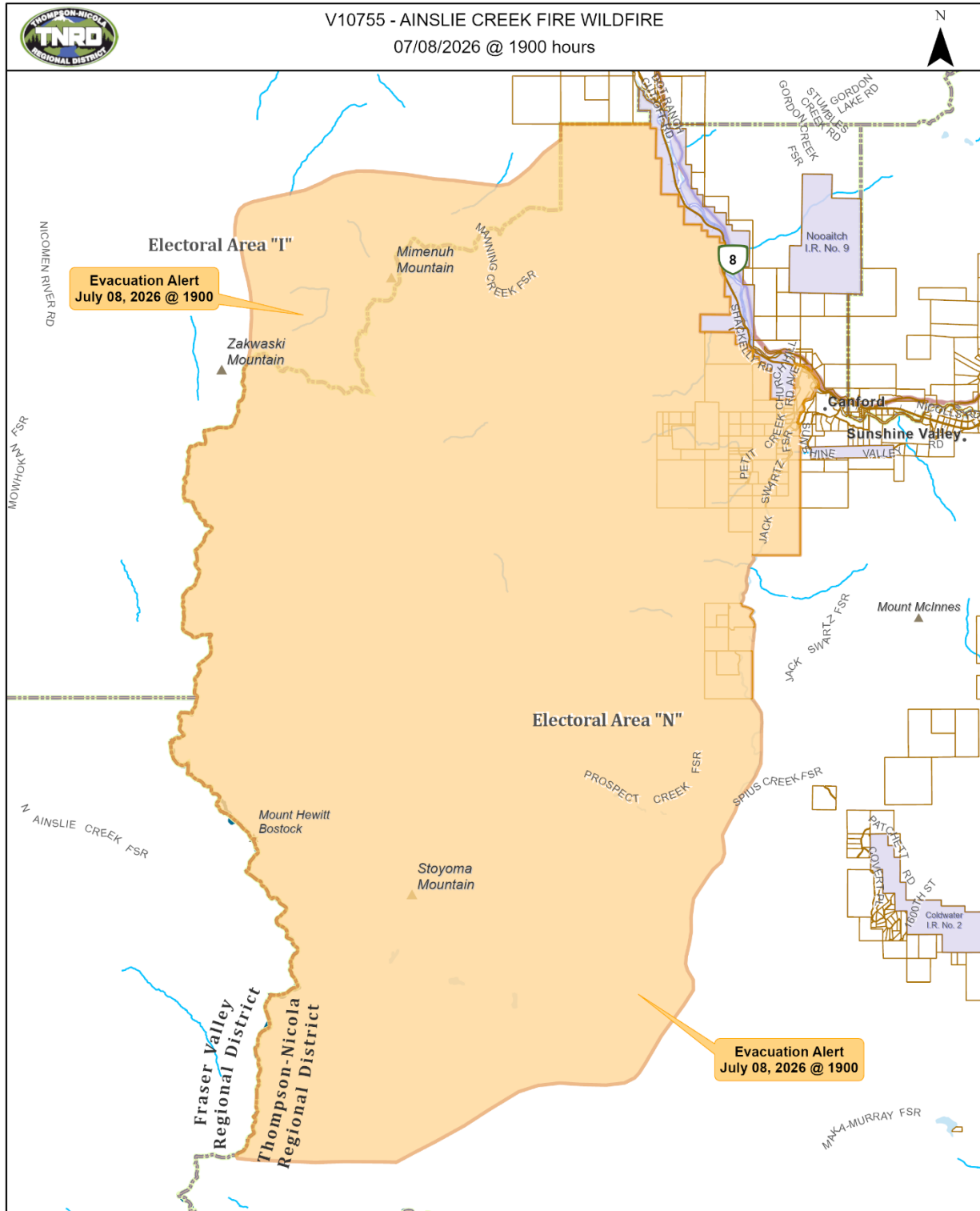


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
