EVACUATION ALERT

Fiftynine Creek Wildfire

July 17, 2026, 2030 hrs

An **Evacuation Alert** has been issued by the Thompson-Nicola Regional District, effective July 17, 2026 at 2030 hours, due to the Fiftynine Creek Wildfire.

The Evacuation Alert is now in effect for approximately 63 addressed properties in Electoral Area "E" (**Bonaparte Plateau**).

Impacted areas are as follows:

- **The area West of the current Evacuation Order area to Poison Lake Road, and**
- **The area East of the current Evacuation Order area to Hwy 97; and**
- **Any other properties outlined on the attached map.**

This Evacuation Alert is in place to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to an Evacuation Order; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

What You Should Do:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be issued while separated.
- Pack essential items for quick departure, such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), and immediate care needs for dependents or pets. Pack keepsakes if time permits.
- Prepare a grab-and-go bag with clothing, toiletries, food, water, and medications.
- Plan where you will stay. Make arrangements with family or friends; accommodation may be limited to cots in comingled shelters during emergencies.

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- If you require public aid assistance with lodging, food, or essentials, ensure you have a BCeID digital ID set up, then create or update your BC Emergency Support Services profile at ess.gov.bc.ca.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/ or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and prepare to move animals and livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- If you are a livestock producer, ensure that you have your Premise ID in the event that you require support should an Evacuation Order be issued.
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles to be used in case of an Evacuation Order.

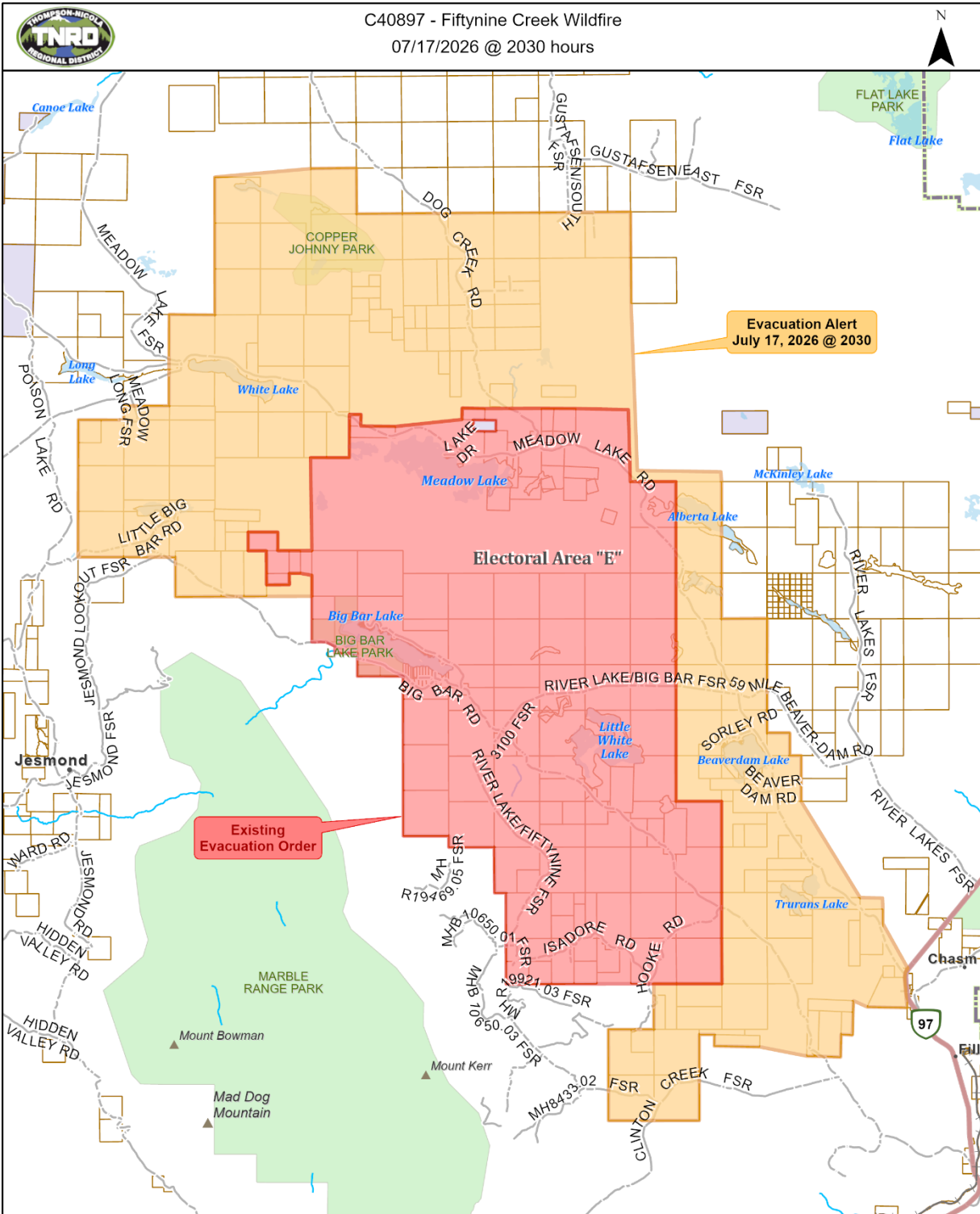


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
