EVACUATION ALERT

Pear Lake Wildfire (merged with Fiftynine Creek Wildfire)

July 27, 2026, at 1000 hours

An **Evacuation Alert** has been issued by the Thompson-Nicola Regional District, effective July 27, 2026 at 1000 hours, due to ongoing threat of the merged Pear Lake and Fiftynine Creek wildfires.

The Evacuation Alert is now in effect for approximately 7 addressed properties in Electoral Area **"E" (Bonaparte Plateau)**.

The following Impacted areas previously issued under JO-086 on July 25, 2026, at 1200 hours will **remain** on Alert:

- **8400 Big Bar Rd;**
- **8500 Big Bar Rd;**
- **8600 Big Bar Rd;**
- **8605 Big Bar Rd;**
- **7620 Meadow Lake Rd;**
- **7624 Meadow Lake Rd;**
- **7628 Meadow Lake Rd; and**
- **Any other properties as outlined on the attached map.**

This Evacuation Alert is in place to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to an Evacuation Order; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

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What You Should Do:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be issued while separated.
- Pack essential items for quick departure, such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), and immediate care needs for dependents or pets. Pack keepsakes if time permits.
- Prepare a grab-and-go bag with clothing, toiletries, food, water, and medications.
- Make arrangements to stay with family or friends; accommodation may be limited to cots in comingled shelters during emergencies.
- If you require public aid assistance with lodging, food, or essentials, ensure you have a BCeID digital ID set up, then create or update your BC Emergency Support Services profile at ess.gov.bc.ca.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/ or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and prepare to move animals and livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- If you are a livestock producer, ensure that you have your Premise ID in the event that you require support should an Evacuation Order be issued.
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles to be used in case of an Evacuation Order.
- Consider removing perishable items from your fridge, or plan to take them with you should an Evacuation Order be issued.

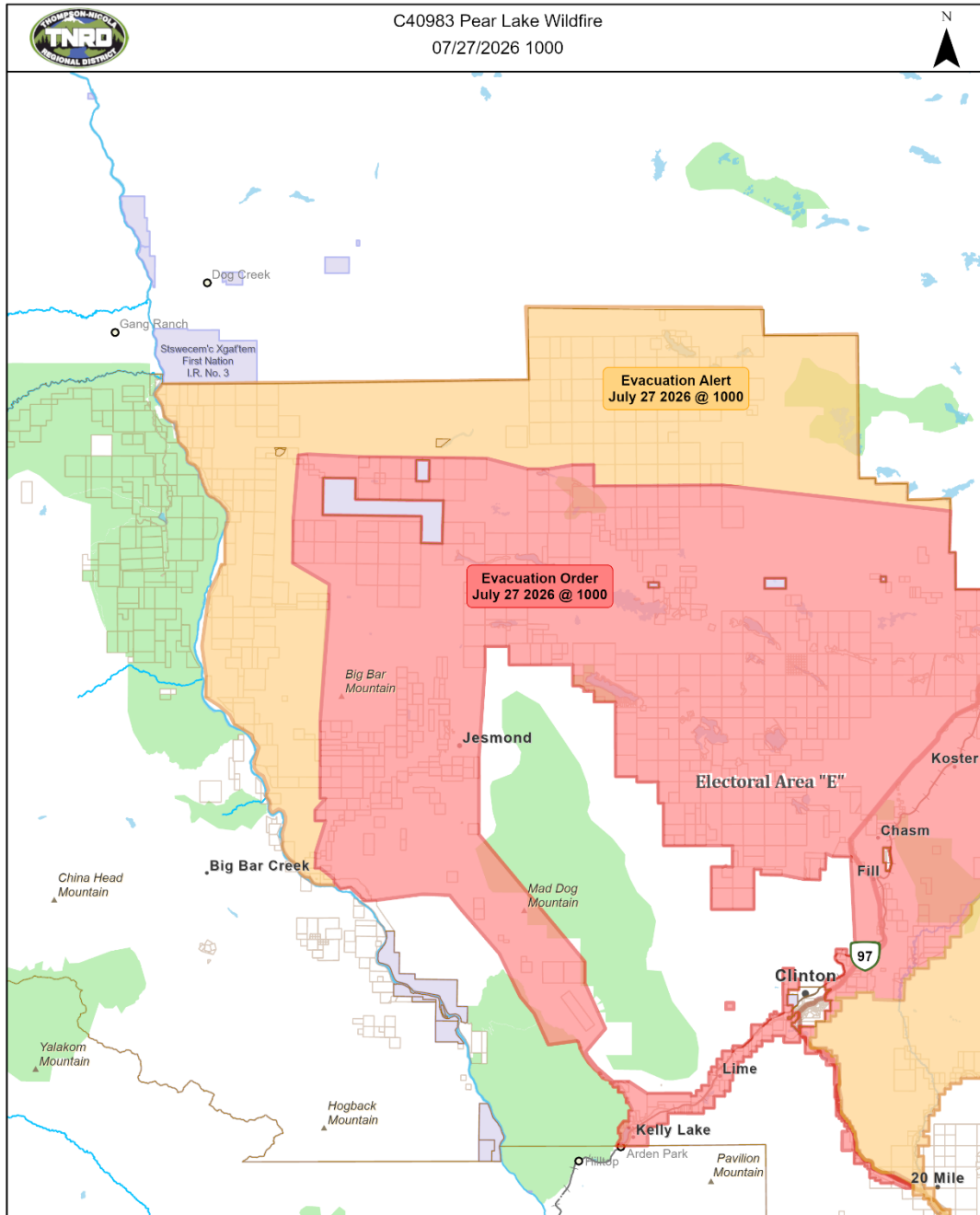


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
