# **EVACUATION ORDER**

## **Rim Lake Wildfire**

**July 27, 2026 at 1300 hours**

WHEREAS a declaration of a State of Local Emergency was made on July 16, 2026 pursuant to Section 95 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* due to wildfire within the jurisdiction of the Thompson-Nicola Regional District,

AND pursuant to Section 107 (1)(c) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*,

An **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Thompson-Nicola Regional District due to immediate danger to life safety caused by the Rim Lake Fire effective as of July 27, 2026 at 1300 hours.

This Evacuation Order is now in effect for approximately 2 addressed properties in Electoral Area "E" (Bonaparte Plateau).

Impacted areas are as follows:

- **9340 Rose Road;**
- **4415 Clinton-Loon Lake FSR; and**
- **Any other properties as outline in the attached map.**

If you are in the described area, **you must leave immediately**. A person must not enter the Evacuation Order area for purposes of residing, occupying, or visiting the area.

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## What You Should Do:

- To receive Emergency Support Services (ESS), please self-register through one of the following methods:
  - use the Evacuee Registration & Assistance tool: [ess.gov.bc.ca](https://ess.gov.bc.ca); or
  - report to the ESS Reception Centre, located at 1655 Island Parkway, Kamloops
  - if you need assistance refer to the Provincial ESS website (<https://ess.gov.bc.ca/>)
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, keys) only if they are immediately available. Take your grab-and-go bag if you have one prepared.
- Transport pets in kennels or on a leash.
- Close gate latches, but do not lock gates.
- Power is often lost in evacuation areas; consider how to manage perishable foods and appliances within your home.
- Do not turn off your natural gas. FortisBC will turn off natural gas service as needed.
- Gather your family and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles than you need to.
- If you require transportation assistance from the area, advise the person providing this emergency notice, or call the TNRD at: 250-377-7188.
- Make arrangements to stay with family or friends; accommodation may be limited during emergencies.
- If you require public aid assistance with lodging, food, or essentials, make sure you have a BCeID digital ID set up, then create or update your BC Emergency Support Services profile at [ess.gov.bc.ca](https://ess.gov.bc.ca).

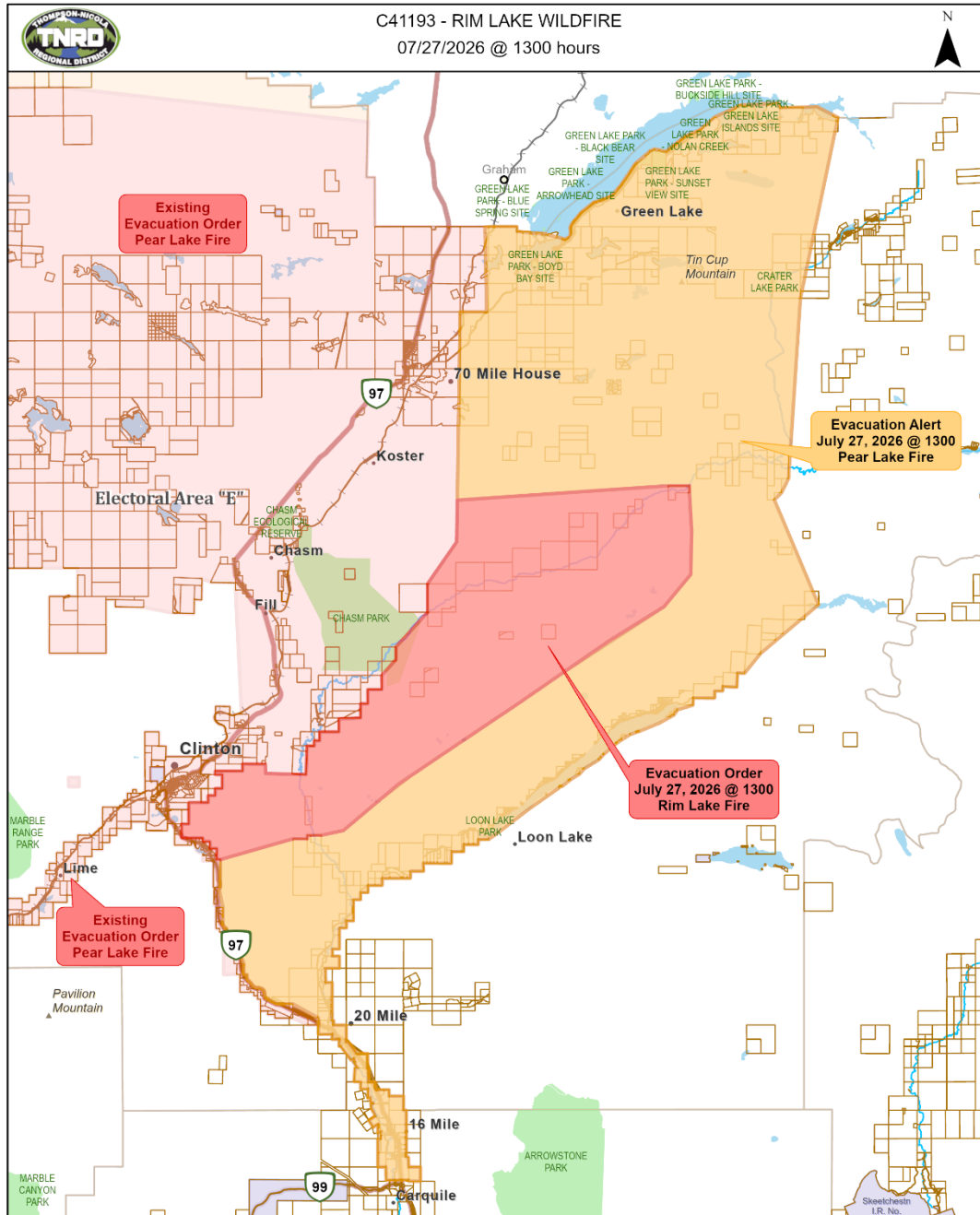


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
